

## Central Coast Oztag Association 2021 Junior Nationals Code of Conduct

All players and parents also agree to the Central Coast Oztag Code of Conduct below;

It is the requirement of a representative player to:

- Accept the conditions set by Central Coast Oztag Management Committee and by my coach, and will adhere to these conditions.
- Display honourable sporting behaviour both on and off the field at all times including conduct to opposition players, coaching staff and officials.
- Wear the official uniform as directed by Central Coast Management Committee and abide by the instructions of the Committee.
- Abide by both the rules and spirit of the sport.
- Be available for training sessions organised by Central Coast Oztag Coaching Staff.
- Inform my coach and Central Coast Oztag Management Committee of any personal injury, medical condition or other event that will affect my ability to train and play Representative Oztag.
- Comply with the Oztag Players Code of Conduct.
- Comply with Oztag Australia's social media policy (available on <a href="www.oztag.com.au">www.oztag.com.au</a>)
- Agree to the use, in print and electronic publications which promote Central Coast Oztag, of images or video.
- Play by the rules.
- Abide by Australian Oztag's 'zero punch policy'
- Play within the spirit of the game, whether winning or losing.
- Do not bully or take unfair advantage of another team mate or competitor.
- Ensure that the coaching staff are treated with respect and are given undivided attention.
- Respect the rights, dignity and worth of all participants regardless of their gender, ability, cultural background or religion.
- Refrain from any form of sexual harassment towards players or other officials.
- Will not drink alcohol at a junior event and will not arrive at a venue intoxicated on under the influence of drugs.
- Accept responsibility for your actions and decisions.
- Thank the opposition and officials at the end of the game.
- Represent Central Coast Oztag in a positive manner off the field and treat everyone with respect and following rules set down by accommodation providers e.g. Park Beach Holiday Park
- Ensure that you follow directions of Australian Oztag or Central Coast Oztag staff members at the tournament including at accommodation venues.

## It is the requirement of a parent/guardian to:

- Never argue or threaten a player or official.
- Control your temper. Verbal abuse of officials or other players, deliberately distracting or provoking an opponent are not acceptable or permitted.
- Ensure that the coaching staff are treated with respect and follow their direction when required.
- Will not consume alcohol and/or drugs at the playing venue.
- Accept responsibility for your actions and decisions.
- Ensure that there is clear communication with the coach in the event that your son/daughter has any issues preventing them from attending any events including training.
